The purpose of the Public Meeting is to present information and collect public input on the City's upcoming grant application to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection Office of Greenways and Trails.


Funding from this grant application will be used to design and construct the Amphibious Base Trail, a recreational/memorial trail to commemorate the more than 140,000 Army, Navy and Coast Guard recruits who trained in Fort Pierce, a nationally recognized US Naval Amphibious Training Base, between 1943-1946.

Funding from this grant application will also be used to purchase and install bike rental, fix it and mobility tracking stations and bike racks, which will heighten the usability of the growing array of recreational and cultural trails in and around the City.

The public is invited to attend this Public Meeting and participate in the discussion regarding the proposed application.

The Public Meeting will be held Monday, March 26, 2012, from 12:00 Noon until 1:00 p.m. in the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor conference room at City Hall. The Fort Pierce City Hall is located at 100 North U.S. Hwy. 1 in Fort Pierce.
