City of Fort Pierce Seeks Public Input With PAL Park Development Survey and Community Meeting

The City of Fort Pierce is currently applying to the Florida Recreation Development Assistance Program (FRDAP) for funding to complete Phase I of a 2-phase project to develop Police Athletic League (PAL) Park, located at 903 South 21st Street. Citizens are encouraged to contribute ideas for the development of PAL Park by completing an online survey and attending a community meeting.

A community meeting will be held Tuesday, September 18, 2012, at 12:00 Noon at the PAL Center, 901 South 21st Street. City staff will provide a short PowerPoint presentation and hard copy surveys will be available. A question and answer time will be provided and citizens will be encouraged to comment and make suggestions for the development of the park.
