Moore's Creek Linear Park Ribbon Cutting Arbor Day Recognition

The City of Fort Pierce will hold a ribbon cutting ceremony for the newly redesigned Moore's Creek Linear Park on Thursday, October 28, 2010, 10:00 a.m. at the park entrance just south of 435 N. 7th Street in Fort Pierce.

The project encompasses approximately 3,500 feet from 7th Street to 15th Street, decorative bridges at 8th, 9th, Dundas and 14th Streets, sidewalks, lighting and landscaping along Moore's Creek. The project began September 2007 at a cost of approximately \$12 million with funding sources from South Florida Water Management District, Federal Emergency Management Agency and Florida Recreational Development Assistance Program, Fort Pierce Redevelopment Agency, Florida Communities Trust and the City's Stormwater Management Utility.

The event will recognize October 28, 2010 as Arbor Day in the City of Fort Pierce which assists with recertification for the City's 22nd year "Tree City" designation.
