### NOTICE TO ALL CONTRACTORS

All persons performing work requiring a license as a contractor pursuant to FSS 489.105(3)(a)-(q) and/or Fort Pierce construction licensing ordinances must be performed by a properly licensed contractor, subcontractor, or an “employee” of such contractor or subcontractor.

A building contractor shall subcontract all electrical, mechanical, plumbing, roofing, sheet metal, swimming pool, and air conditioning work, unless such contractor holds a state certificate or registration in the respective trade category.

For all other work being subcontracted, if a license is required pursuant to FSS 489.105(3)(d)-(q) and/or Fort Pierce construction licensing ordinances; the subcontractor must be properly licensed. A list of all subcontractors must be submitted to our office prior to the subcontractors commencing work.

An “employee” is defined as a person who receives compensation from and is under the supervision and control of an employer who regularly deducts the F.I.C.A. and withholding tax and provides workers’ compensation, all as prescribed by law.

**FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE ABOVE PROVISIONS MAY RESULT IN CIVIL AND/OR CRIMINAL ACTION TAKEN AGAINST BOTH, THE UNLICENSED CONTRACTOR, AND THE CONTRACTOR INVOLVED IN SUCH CONSTRUCTION.**
