GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

Highly skilled advanced mechanic work of the journeyman level in the repair and maintenance of automotive-related equipment, under the supervision of others including a Foreman and Supervisor.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

1. Repairs and overhauls automobiles, trucks, and other equipment.
2. Rebuilds and repairs engines, transmissions, universal joints and differentials.
3. Performs diagnostic functions using hand held engine scopes, volt/OMH testing units, scan tools, and other equipment designed for these purposes.
4. Rebuilds, repairs and installs electrical automotive apparatus, such as starters, alternators, distributors, auto air conditioning, electrical windshield wipers, voltage regulators, electrical wiring repair, sirens, spotlights and other special police or emergency vehicle apparatus.
5. Must be familiar with preventative maintenance procedures.
6. Repairs diesel and gasoline fuel systems, to include troubleshooting, and component replacing.
7. May perform work on small engines and equipment.
8. Performs calls for service, and/or repairs in the field as required.

(These essential job functions are not to be construed as a complete statement of all duties performed. Employees will be required to perform other job related marginal duties as required.)

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

- Knowledge of construction, design, repair and adjustment of diesel and gasoline engines, where such engines are used for power.
- Knowledge of tools and equipment needed for major and minor repairs of diesel and gasoline engines. Must possess basic hand tools required to perform routine maintenance and repair tasks.
- Knowledge of hydraulic and or brake systems.
- Knowledge of both light and heavy-duty electrical systems.
- Knowledge of the principles of operation of diesel and gasoline internal combustion engines.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES (cont'd):

- Ability to diagnose defects and failures of diesel and gasoline engines.
- Ability to follow oral and written instructions.
- Must possess general computer knowledge.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

High school graduation or possession of an acceptable equivalency diploma. Two (2) years experience at the journeyman level, as an automotive or diesel mechanic.

(A comparable amount of training, education or experience can be substituted for the minimum qualifications.)

LICENSES, CERTIFICATIONS OR REGISTRATIONS:

Must possess a valid Class "B" commercial Florida Driver's License.

ESSENTIAL PHYSICAL SKILLS:
