A DECLARATION OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF FORT PIERCE **DECLARING A LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY IN** THE CITY OF FORT PIERCE (HURRICANE IAN)

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Fort Pierce has made the following determinations:

Pursuant to Chapter 14, Article II, Section 14-21 of the City of Fort Pierce Code of 1.

Ordinances (hereinafter the "City Code"), the Mayor has the power to declare a local state of

emergency within the City of Fort Pierce whenever the Mayor has determined that a natural or

manmade disaster or emergency has occurred or that the occurrence or threat of one is imminent

and requires immediate and expeditious action.

The National Hurricane Center has identified Hurricane Ian as a hurricane and has 2.

issued a Tropical Storm Warning for the east coast of Florida, including St. Lucie County.

The Governor of the State of Florida issued Executive Orders 22-218 and 22-219 3.

dated September 23, 2022 and September 24, 2022, respectively, declaring a state of emergency

that includes St. Lucie County.

Executive Orders 22-218 and 22-219, in accordance with Section 252.38, Florida

Statutes, authorizes local governments to take whatever prudent action is necessary to ensure the

health, safety, and welfare of the community.

The presence of Hurricane Ian has placed the City of Fort Pierce in a state of 5.

emergency, exposing the citizens thereof to the threat of imminent violence and to danger to life

and property.

In order to respond to such emergency, upon this Declaration, the City Manager is

authorized to initiate and take such actions authorized by state and local law, including Chapter

252, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 14, Article II, Emergency Management, of the City Code during

the term of such local state of emergency.
