Public Notice – City of Fort Pierce Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program Amendments

Notice of Availability and Public Hearing on Proposed Substantial Amendments to Program Years (PY) 2024–2025 CDBG Annual Action Plans

In accordance with the requirements of 24 CFR Part 91.105(c), the City of Fort Pierce proposes to reallocate unspent funds from prior program years to support shovel-ready projects currently in need of additional funding.

Notice is hereby given of the proposed changes to the City’s Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, amending the Annual Action Plans for Program Years (PY) 2024-2025.

Amendment No. 1 – Funding Reallocation

Activity Names: Public Facilities, Housing Rehabilitation, and Capital Projects. **Description:** Funding will be reallocated for the following projects in the amounts indicated: Public Facilities: (3 City Parks) \$1,117,599; Housing Rehabilitation: (11 City Homes) \$1,100,000; Capital Project: (Emergency Vehicle Preemption System) \$296,976; **Total:** \$2,514,575.

These funds will be reallocated from available balances from PY 2021, 2022, 2023, and 2024. These are federal funds and will have no impact on the City’s general fund budget. The amendment is in accordance with U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) regulations and will allow projects to proceed toward timely completion in compliance with program requirements.

The public comment period will begin on **June 20, 2025, at 12:00 PM** and end on **July 20, 2025, at 12:00 PM**. A public hearing to review these changes and receive comments will be held at the regularly scheduled **City Commission Meeting** on: **Monday, July 21, 2025, at 5:05 PM, Commission Chambers, Fort Pierce City Hall**, 100 North U.S. Highway 1, Fort Pierce, Florida 34950.
