 Know all men by these presents: That the CITY OF FORT PIERCE, a municipal corporation, created under the laws of Florida, has, and by these presents does, donate and dedicate to the use of the Public forever the Streets, Avenues, Highways and Alleys designated and laid out upon this plat; Also, The land shown on said plat as "PROPOSED CITY PARK" is hereby dedicated and set apart by the said City to be used for and as a public park and pleasure ground and for the purposes of amusement and recreation and the same to be enjoyed for such purposes by the Public generally, the said City having the right to adopt reasonable rules and regulations in regard to said property, and said City obligates itself to forever preserve and use the property hereinabove designated, for the purposes and objects as set forth in the deeds of conveyance of said property to the City, and the City obligates itself to keep the property in a reasonable state of repair for the use and enjoyment by the Public generally as a place for amusement, pleasure and recreation.
